CAUSES OF WORLD WAR ONE

IMMEDIATE CAUSE:

- June 28th, 1914, 10:00 a.m. Archduke Franz Ferdinand and his wife, Archduchess Sophia, were assassinated in Sarajevo
 - the Archduke was the heir to the Austro-Hungarian throne
- the assassin, Gavrilo Princip, was a member of a Serbian terrorist group known as *Black hand*
- A series of events led to the start of the war
 - Austria-Hungary declared war on Serbia;
 - Russia supporting Serbia, mobilized against Austria-Hungary;
 - France supporting Russia, also mobilized;
 - Germany declared war on Russia, and on France the next day;
 - Germany then invaded France through Belgium;
 - Protecting Belgium's neutrality, Britain declared war on Germany;
 - World War I began
